

# INFORMATION AND CONSENT TO THE PROCESSING OF USERS' PERSONAL DATA FOR THE TERRIFIC PROJECT "NEWSLETTER" SERVICE PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR")

## Premise

The newsletter is distributed by e-mail - automatically and free of charge - to all those who request it by filling out the form at the following link: <https://terrificproject.eu/media/>

We inform you that the personal data you provide and, as well as the data acquired by filling in the appropriate newsletter subscription form, will be processed in compliance with the provisions of EU Regulation no. 2016/679 (for the sake of brevity "GDPR").

## Data Controller

## Categories of Data Processed

The Data Controller processes personal data of a common nature (name, surname, e-mail address; browsing data such as IP address, addresses in URI/URL notation, etc.) that will be provided when the user fills in the required fields in the appropriate subscription form to the newsletter-mailing list.

## Purposes of the Processing, legal basis of the Processing and methods of Processing

The processing of your data by means of computer and telematic tools (and/or manual tools) is aimed at sending commercial, informative and/or technical-specialist information through newsletters - mailing lists relating to the Terrific Project initiative.

The legal basis for this processing is to be found in the consent expressed by the data subject pursuant to art. 6 paragraph 1 letter a) GDPR and for the fulfilment of the legal obligations to which the Data Controller is subject pursuant to art. 6 para. 1 lit. c) GDPR. It should be noted that the communication of the common personal data indicated above is a necessary condition for receiving the newsletters.

Your data will be processed by the Data Controller, by Spring's staff and collaborators (internal or external, natural or legal persons), expressly authorized by the Data Controller, for service maintenance needs and for the correct sending of e-mails.

## Data retention period

The personal data collected for the purposes indicated in the previous paragraph will be processed in order to provide the requested service and, consequently, will be stored for the period in which the subscription to the newsletter is active, i.e. until you revoke your consent and request cancellation from the service. Following the cancellation of the service, the technical procedures necessary for the deletion of your data will be carried out, except for any need to ascertain crimes (and/or other types of offences) by the judicial authorities.

## Categories of recipients of Personal Data

The data subject to processing may be communicated, in addition to the subjects referred to in the *last sentence "Purposes of processing, legal basis of processing and processing methods"* paragraph, also to the judicial authority for the need to ascertain unlawful acts.

### **Withdrawal of consent**

You have the right to withdraw your consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.

### **Rights of the data subject**

In relation to the data subject to the processing referred to in this policy, you are recognized, at any time, the right to:

- Access (art. 15 EU Regulation no. 2016/679) – the right to request and obtain from the Data Controller confirmation that the processing of your data is being carried out and access to the data concerning the data subject (including to know the purpose of the processing, the categories of data processed).
- Rectification (art. 16 EU Regulation no. 2016/679) – allows you to request the Data Controller to correct, modify, integrate your personal data.
- Erasure (art. 17 EU Regulation no. 2016/679) – allows you to obtain the deletion of your data without justified delay (so-called right to be forgotten).
- Restriction (art. 18 EU Regulation no. 2016/679) – the right to obtain a limitation on the processing of the data subject's data, for example, in addition to the exercise of the right referred to in art. 16 for as long as necessary to ascertain the correctness of the data.
- Portability (art. 20 EU Regulation no. 2016/679) – allows the data subject to receive personal data concerning him or her so that he or she can transmit them to another Data Controller.
- **Objection to processing (art. 21 EU Regulation no. 2016/679) – allows the data subject to object to the processing of personal data concerning him/her.**

### **Complaint**
